

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between
University of Rijeka
and
Northumbria University

As part of an effort to contribute to the globalisation of higher education, the University of Rijeka and Northumbria University hereby agree to work together to develop academic and cultural exchange programs in the area of education, research, and other activities.

This Agreement of Cooperation signifies a statement of intent to collaborate, but is not a legally binding document.

The area of cooperation, which consists of the following categories, can, in principle, include any programme presently offered, or to be offered, at either school that is deemed mutually beneficial.

- A. Exchange programme for academic staff
- B. Student exchange programmes
- C. Cultural programme exchange
- D. Joint research projects
- E. Joint conference

Any proposal for a specific programme, which can be initiated by either school, shall first be fully discussed by the working level officers of both parties and be subject to the final approval of the presidents of both schools before being implemented.

Separate agreements for any collaboration agreed, including for advanced entry to Northumbria programmes, are required. The parties understand that any financial considerations associated with any forms of collaboration will be dealt with separately via a legal contract.

Northumbria University recognises the value of this Agreement of Co-operation with the University of Rijeka in promoting its programmes and activities, but any promotional material/activity which includes reference to Northumbria University must be sent to and be approved by the Dean of the relevant Northumbria School before use.

This agreement shall become effective upon the signing of both parties and is for 5 years in the first instance, and will be reviewed thereafter. Each party has the right to terminate the agreement at any time subject to a period of 12 months' notice being given. In any cases of discontinuance, the parties will honour agreed commitments either via the accepted arrangements or suitable alternatives negotiated at that point.
