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Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences of the University of Rijeka announces a Call for enrollment in the *Youth in Contemporary Society* lifelong learning programme 2020/2021.

The programme is a result of the collaboration between the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences of the University of Rijeka, Institute for Social Research in Zagreb and University of Ljubljana.

Professionals already engaged in youth work, or those interested in working with the youth and for the youth as a specific social group, are invited to apply to the *Youth in contemporary society* lifelong learning programme.

Applications are open from: the day of the announcement at the official web-pages of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Rijeka

Application deadline: 1st February 2021

Notification on the selection of attendees: 3rd February 2021

Beginning of the programme implementation: 19th February 2021

Programme duration: 15 weeks (beginning with 19th February 2021)

Place and time of the programme implementation: Classes are held in a hybrid form, in a combination of f2f lectures at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Rijeka (Fridays afternoon and Saturdays during the day), part of the f2f lectures will be held in the Moise Palace on the island of Cres, while part of the program will be online via LearnPress system for distance learning. The schedule of classes will be given to the participants upon enrollment. The dynamics of the implementation of f2f classes will be subject to adaptation to epidemiological measures and in the period when its implementation will not be possible, teaching will take place online using the platform for distance learning.

Type of programme: Training programme with ECTS credits. The whole programme is worth **30 ECTS credits**.

The number of attendees is limited for 30 participants.

Important note: The costs of tuition, travel and accommodation for all 30 participants will be covered from the “Supporting Evidence-based Education of Youth Workers” project, funded by the Croatian Agency for Mobility and European Union Programs (AMPEU).

Conditions for enrollment:

1. Completed undergraduate or (pre-bologna) graduate study
2. Knowledge of English at the level adequate for following the lessons and reading the literature
3. Computer Based skills

The application has to be submitted electronically with the following documents

1. CV
2. Copy of Diploma
3. Motivational letter (minimum 500 words)

Programme description

Youth in Contemporary Society lifelong learning programme is a response to society's clearly articulated need for an educational programme based on scientific research of youth as a specific social group. Acknowledging this, the *Youth in Contemporary Society* educational programme offers an array of knowledge and skills arising from a number of social disciplines needed for grasping the larger social context (with a particular focus on the Croatian society) in which the young are the main actors and/or a specifically targeted group. The programme is unique in Croatia, however it is comparable with the most prestigious similar programmes across the European Union, and as such represents an inevitable component of contemporary social sciences.

Youth in Contemporary Society lifelong learning programme consists of **three modules** jointly covering the most important topics from the domain of youth – **(I) youth research, (II) youth work and (III) youth and community development.**

Type of classes: A combination of f2f lectures (every second weekend, Fridays afternoons and all-day Saturdays), residential lectures, community-based research and practical engagement, accompanied by the distance learning system and a continuous mentor support.

Languages of instruction: Croatian; English
