Submit Your Question to Mr. Kristof

- High school and university students from around the world have the opportunity to submit their thoughtful, informed questions, for Mr. Kristof on the topic of the media's responsibility to promote Social Justice.
- Questions must be video recorded vertically in MP4 format (standard IPhone Recording)
- Each question should be no longer than 20 30 seconds in length.
- Submit all questions using **Echo's Registration Link** by March 21st.
- When recording a question, state your name, school, city/state/country before asking your question.
- Ensure that both your **Echo Registration** and the **MP4 video question** include correct information.
- Name each file as follows: firstnamelastname.city.

- Submitted questions will be curated and presented to Mr. Kristof on April 13th, as part of the Echo Student Dialogue.
- Nicholas Kristof will respond live to student submitted pre-recorded video questions.
- As many questions as possible will be presented as time allows.
