

Course Topics

In "Cultural Landscapes & Urban Resilience" participants develop an integrated urban design concept that considers urban resilience in the context of climate-sensitive planning. The course includes lectures on the more general context of urban resilience, a GIS-training and it's application to map urban heat islands of informal and formal housing areas in Cairo. Finally, the findings are interpreted to create design solutions that respond to urban heat in the physical, cultural and social context. In addition to the course, the Bauhaus Summer School offers a diverse cultural programme in Weimar and Thuringia.
