

# ABOUT THE ERASMUS TRAINEESHIP PROGRAMME:

The traineeship programme can be attended in the period **from 1 June 2023 to 21 July 2025** in **countries of the European Union, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Serbia, Macedonia or Turkey.** 

The traineeship programme is **held full-time**, provided that the sending higher education institution recognises it as part of the study programme. If this is not possible, the completed traineeship will be entered in the Diploma Supplement.

Students can attend the traineeship programme **within one year of completing their studies** (graduation), but they apply for the Call for applications while they have **student status**. In that case, upon completion of the traineeship programme, the Erasmus International Mobility Centre will issue the student with a certificate of the completed traineeship signed by the Madam Rector of the University of Rijeka.

The student is obliged to find the institution where he/she wants to attend the traineeship programme! The Call for applications published by the University of Rijeka is always open and the applications are processed immediately!

#### **DURATION:**

- long-term mobility: 2–12 months
- blended mobility: 5–30 days (physical mobility + virtual component)

### WHERE CAN STUDENTS ATTEND THE TRAINEESHIP PROGRAMME?

# FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

- EUR 650/700 per month for long-term mobility (depending on the country where mobility is achieved)
- EUR 79 per day for mobility lasting 5–14 days, EUR 56 per day from the 15<sup>th</sup> to the 30<sup>th</sup> day for blended mobility
- additional financial support for green travel (carpooling, bus, train, bicycle)
- additional financial support for students with fewer opportunities (most common categories: low socio-economic status, parents have a lower level of education, father is a Croatian Homeland War veteran, students with disabilities... check the conditions in the Call for applications!)

# FINAL STEP:

- Once you have found and agreed on the Erasmus traineeship programme, send your application to the UNIRI Call for applications (remember to send your application form at least 30 days before the start of the traineeship programme).
