The University of Rijeka has signed Erasmus cooperation agreements with more than 870 institutions in the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Macedonia, Malta, The Netherlands, Norway, Germany, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and Great Britain.

ERASMUS 2025/2026

The University of Rijeka has been participating in Erasmus since 2009. The program enables students, teaching and non-teaching staff of the University to stay in one of the countries participating in the Erasmus+ program for the purpose of study, traineeship, teaching or training.

STUDENT MOBILITY

Erasmus provides students with various mobility types: studies, traineeship, a combination of studies and traineeship, combined physical and virtual (blended) mobility, short-term doctoral student mobility or attending Blended Intensive Programs / BIPs at foreign institutions.

Duration of student mobility:

- · studies 2 12 months (min 60 days, max 360 days)
- traineeship 2 12 months (min 60 days, max 360)
- · combined blended student mobility or BIP 5-30 days of physical mobility + mandatory virtual mobility
- · short-term mobility of doctoral students 5-30 days Traineeship can be completed within a period of 12 months after the end of studies (graduation).

Financial support for long term mobility of students:

· od 500-550 EUR/month (depends on the country)

- + 250 FUR/month for students of lower socioeconomic status and students with fewer opportunities
- + 150 EUR/month for traineeship
- + financial support for travel/green travel (carpooling, bus, train, bicycle)

Financial support for short-term student mobility:

- 79 EUR/day for mobility from 5th to 14th day 56 EUR/day for mobility from 15th to 30th day
- + 100 EUR and travel expenses for students with fewer opportunities for mobility lasting from 5-14 days
- + 150 EUR and travel expenses for students with fewer opportunities for mobility lasting from 15-30 days
- + financial support for travel/green travel (carpooling, bus, train, bicycle)



STAFF MOBILITY

Teaching staff can apply for mobility for the purpose of teaching (at least 8 hours of teaching per week), for the purpose of professional training and for the purpose of combining teaching and training (4 hours of teaching per week). Non-teaching staff can apply for staff training mobility.

Mobility duration:

- · teaching 2 days 2 months
- · training 2 days 2 months Financial support;
- · daily grant + travel costs

Professional training activities:

- · monitoring the work of colleagues at a foreign institution when performing their professional activities (job shadowing)
- · professional training workshop/course

The basic condition for the selection of teaching and nonteaching staff is the quality of the work plan.

SENERAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- Mobility is only possible at higher education institutions that have been awarded the Erasmus University Charter and with which the University of Rijeka has signed an Erasmus co-operation agreement, except in the case of student traineeships and staff
- The home university must recognise the ECTS credits or other credits earned by the student during the

mobility.

- Tuition fees and fees are not paid to a foreign institution.
- Double funding is not permitted. Students and staff cannot receive financial support under Erasmus if their stay is also funded by the European Union funds.
- Students and staff are obliged to take out health insurance policy for the duration of their mobility.
- A student can receive financial support for mobility under Erasmus for a total period of 12 months for any level of study: undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate, regardless of the type of mobility (study, traineeship, BIP).
- Students and staff with disabilities and students with fewer opportunities are entitled to additional financial support.
- Students who are in their final year of undergraduate studies at the time of applying for this call and are applying for study mobility in their first year of graduate studies may only apply for mobility in the summer term.
- A student at a foreign institution must take at least 20 ECTS credits and achieve at least 15 ECTS credits in one. semester
- A student who will be writing a thesis or dissertation at a foreign institution and has fulfilled all other obligations at the home institution must enrol for and pass at least one elective course at the foreign institution and earn at least 4 ECTS credits, which will be entered in the Diploma Supplement upon return.
