The joint Bachelor in Urban Sustainability Studies, designed by the Young Universities for the Future of Europe (YUFE) Alliance, offers an innovative, interdisciplinary and challenge-based education to tackle real-life challenges head-on. Customise your learning path, explore diverse landscapes, and lead the way in urban sustainability across Europe with YUFE!

Over three dynamic years, you will shape your learning journey to match your strengths and interests. The first year covers essential skills at your starting university. In the second and third years, you personalise your studies through YUFE minors and study at a minimum of three different universities across Europe. The programme culminates in a dissertation to showcase your expertise. You finish the Bachelor with a joint degree awarded by seven European Universities.

Throughout your bachelor's programme, you work internationally with students, teachers, and businesses to address real-world issues in a creative, international and interactive setting. With input from ten European universities, each YUFE partner (seven degree-awarding partners and three mobility partners), the programme offers a diverse and applied curriculum that explores sustainability issues in urban and rural settings.

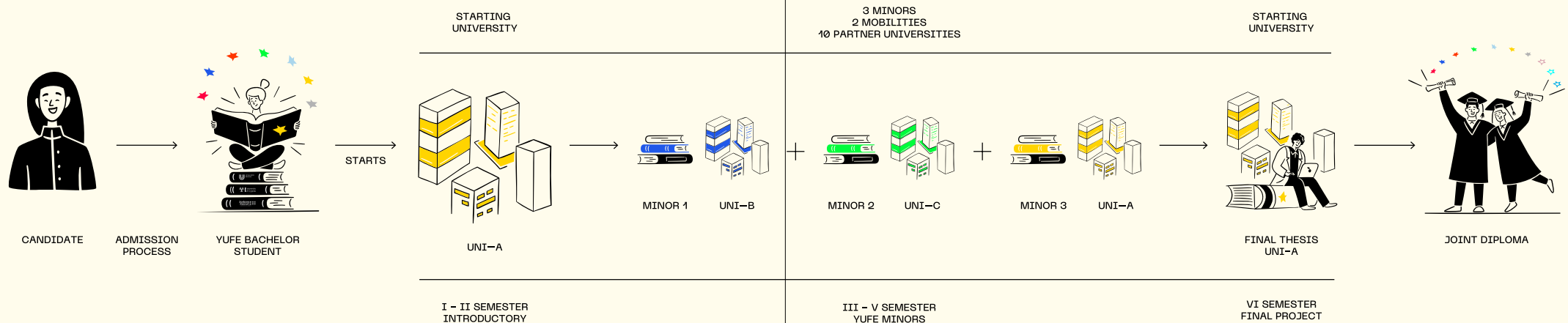
This programme features an open curriculum concept, giving you the flexibility to personalise your studies as you progress.

In your first year with YUFE, you will begin your bachelor's studies at the chosen degree-awarding university, following a jointly designed common curriculum to build a foundation in urban sustainability through a combination of on-site and online courses. The YUFE's Bachelor programme features an open curriculum concept, giving you

the flexibility to personalise your studies as you progress. **In your second year,** you will start taking up YUFE minors. You can select from 20 different minors, choosing three in total, with at least two pursued at universities other than your starting university. This structure enables you to study at multiple three universities, offering a uniquely rich and diverse academic experience.

Your international mobility is supported by Erasmus funding, which helps cover travel and living costs and can support up to two mobilities, allowing you to spend two semesters at universities abroad, making this exceptional global learning opportunity accessible and achievable.

You'll round off your academic profile with a bachelor's thesis project and your choice of elective courses at your starting university.

Upon successful completion of the programme, graduates are awarded a joint Bachelor's degree in Urban Sustainability Studies, conferred jointly by all seven degree-awarding partners.

The YUFE's Bachelor in Urban Sustainability Studies offers you the opportunity to explore insights from a wide range of fields, including social sciences (e. g. economics, business, urbanism, and sociology), natural sciences (e. g. environmental engineering, biology, and ecology), technical sciences (e. g. civil engineering, mechanical engineering, and artificial intelligence), and the humanities.

With this degree, you can pursue various master's programmes, with even more options available depending on your chosen minors. Opportunities will be available at all YUFE partner universities, as well as at institutions worldwide. At UNIRI, you will have the option to pursue a master's programme across different faculties, some of which may require enrolment through a bridging programme or entrance exam.

As a leader in international joint education, the programme prepares you to excel in global collaboration. Upon graduating from the Bachelor programme in Urban Sustainability Studies, you will have already built a strong international network of peers, educators, and industry professionals across Europe.

These competencies will give you a significant advantage in the job market, making you a more competitive and attractive choice for employers in an increasingly globalized professional landscape.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To enrol in the YUFE's joint Bachelor programme in Urban Sustainability Studies you need to have

- 1) a secondary education diploma equivalent to the EQF level 4
- 2) sufficient command of English

To enrol in the YUFE's joint Bachelor programme in Urban Sustainability Studies you need to have

1—(at least) a **secondary education diploma** equivalent to the European Qualification Framework (EQF) level 4, granting access to one of the YUFE universities

2—**sufficient command of English** that can be met through one of the following:

- A**—evidence of English language competence at level B2 or higher on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), as documented in educational policy records from the relevant country or educational authority, or,
- B**—a valid language certificate, not older than two years at the time of application, with the following minimum scores:
- TOEFL iBT (test centre only): 80
 - IELTS2 Academic: 6.5 overall, 6.0 per component
 - ITACE3: B2
 - Cambridge English: B2 First (score 176 or above)
 - PTE 4 Academic: 59
- C**—alternative qualifications and tests with equivalent scores may also be considered.

Exemption from providing language proficiency proof is granted to applicants who have:

- A**—obtained a diploma from an English-taught programme in Australia, English-speaking Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, or the United States; or
- B**—completed an English-taught programme elsewhere, provided the language of instruction is clearly stated on the educational documents.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applying to the joint YUFE's Bachelor programme is streamlined through the Virtual Campus. Below is an overview of the application procedure. For detailed information on the admission process at the University of Rijeka, please visit our website.

Submitting your application:

- A**—apply via the Virtual Campus, where you will specify University of Rijeka as your preferred starting university and demonstrate that you meet the entry requirements (secondary education qualification and sufficient English proficiency).
- B**—you can also express interest in alternative starting universities.

Application deadlines for the University of Rijeka:

Second-round: 10th July 2025

Eligibility assessment:

- A**—once submitted, your application will be reviewed by your preferred starting university to ensure you meet the eligibility criteria.
- B**—as part of your application, you will fill out a questionnaire to help us assess your motivation, understanding of the programme's opportunities, and readiness to shape your academic path. Your answers will also assist the starting university in selecting candidates if applications exceed available spots (20 at UNIRI).

Admission decision:

- A**—eligible applicants will be notified via the Virtual Campus.
- B**—if selection is necessary, it will be based on standardized criteria to ensure fairness and transparency.
- C**—all YUFE universities follow the same admission criteria, ensuring a consistent process regardless of your starting university.

Enrolment

- A**—continue your admission and enrolment process at your chosen starting university. Detailed information and the necessary documentation can be found on the starting university's website.
- B**—if you have been granted admission to the University of Rijeka, you will be contacted by the Admission Officer, who will guide you through all the necessary steps related to enrolment.
