Admission process and deadlines

Admission criteria:

- a secondary education degree
- and a minimum of B2 level in English.

The application process for the YUFE USS at UNIRI consists of **two selection rounds**. The first round serves as the primary admission phase, while the second round is held only if there are still available spots.

Follow the next steps:

Step 1:

Registration in the Virtual Campus

Register at <u>YUFE Virtual Campus</u>, submit the required documents and complete a short motivation questionnaire by:

First-round: 18th May 2025Second-round: 10th July 2025

If you're a non-EEA applicant, we encourage you to submit your diploma by 14th April 2025 to ensure enough time for qualification assessment by the Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education.

Required Documents:

- **Secondary education degree**: A four-year high school diploma or equivalent, meeting university admission criteria in the country of graduation (for applicants completing secondary education in 2025, a confirmation of study status should be provided).
- **Proof of English language proficiency:** A valid language certificate (issued within the past two years) with the following minimum scores: TOEFL iBT (test centre only): 80; IELTS Academic: 6.5 overall, 6.0 per component; ITACE: B2; Cambridge English: B2 First (176 or above); PTE Academic: 59.
- Alternative qualifications and equivalent scores may be considered contact us at admission.yufe@uniri.hr, and we'll let you know!

- Passport or identity card (for EU citizens)
- Completed motivation questionnaire in the Virtual Campus: It covers your interest in the

If you meet the eligibility requirements, you will receive an eligibility notice through the YUFE Virtual Campus:

First round: 19th May 2025

• Second round: 11th July 2025

This notice will allow the admission process to move forward, which may include further selection steps.

Step 2:

Selection

If there are more applicants than available spots at UNIRI, selection will be based on motivation responses, giving priority to those who show responsibility and adaptability for the USS programme.

If you're selected, you'll receive an admission notification via email:

First round: 27th May 2025Second round: 15th July 2025

To secure your spot, you must accept the offer. If you're not selected, you'll be referred to other YUFE universities from your priority list.

Step 3:

Enrolment

Your admission notification will include details on the required documents and submission deadlines for enrolment. If you completed secondary education abroad, your diploma must be recognized by the Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education - UNIRI will handle this process for you.

The annual tuition fee for the YUFE's Bachelor in Urban Sustainability Studies at UNIRI:

€2,500 for EEA students

€5,000 for non-EEA students

The enrolment fee for the 2025/2026 academic year is €55.50. Both the tuition fee and enrolment fee must be paid annually throughout the duration of the programme.

• Second-round: 25th-26th August 2025
